

Simple bag

Cutting out:

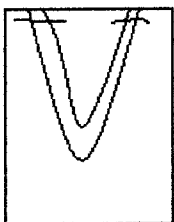
Cut 2 pieces of the outside fabric 5" by 8"

Cut 2 pieces of the lining fabric 5" by 8"

Cut 1 strip 2" by 22" for the handle in one of the fabrics

You also need: Enough fabric for the heart shape and Bondaweb the same size and some embroidery threads for sewing the heart down and for the handle.

1. Iron Bondaweb onto the heart fabric and draw two hearts onto the paper side. Iron the hearts on the outside fabric. Using embroidery thread sew a neat running stitch around the heart to hold it down.
2. **** Hot Iron Warning****
Fold the strip of handle fabric in half lengthways and iron. Open the fabric up then fold in each edge to the middle and iron again. Fold this in half and iron once more. Now sew a neat running stitch with embroidery thread along the length of the handle strip holding all four layers together
3. Put the outside fabric right sides together and sew the two long edges and the bottom edge, turn right side out.
4. Put the lining fabric right sides together and sew the two long edges only
5. Position the handles on the front of the bag as shown and tack in place with a couple of stitches.



6. Turn the bag inside out and put the lining inside the bag so that the outside fabric and the lining fabric right sides are facing each other and you can see the back of both fabrics. Sew around the top of the bag. Turn the bag the right side out.
7. Sew the bottom of the lining with the right side of the fabric outwards. Tuck this inside the bag and its all finished!
